# DBSD Smart Start Re-Opening Framework For 2022-23

The updated Smart Start Framework goes into effect on Monday, August 22nd, 2022.

# **In-Person Learning**

The DBSD School Board prioritizes in-person learning for the 2022-23 school year. The educational needs of our students, availability of multiple layers of effective mitigation actions, and the current nature of the COVID-19 pandemic allows us to provide in-person learning the Denali Borough schools and offices.

# **Distance Learning**

The superintendent is authorized to suspend in-person learning for up to 48 hours and transition to distance learning. This may be decided for one or all school sites, or division within a school in the event of a significant change in the nature of pandemic. Action from the School Board is required if the suspension of in-person learning is to be extended beyond two (2) school days.

Parents choosing a distance learning or virtual school option for their children will be supported through Denali PEAK or the Cantwell Virtual School.

## **Vaccinations**

DBSD encourages everyone who is eligible, to receive a COVID-19 vaccination in order to protect themselves and our community. Through the District Nurse, the district will assist any staff member or student family to schedule a COVID-19 vaccination with an appropriate provider.

# **Face Coverings**

Wearing a well-fitting mask or respirator consistently and correctly reduces the risk of spreading the virus that causes COVID-19. Face coverings such as masks are optional for all students, staff, and visitors in DBSD schools and offices.

# **Screening Tests**

DBSD shall make coronavirus screenings test readily available for all students and staff.

# **Contact Tracing**

The district will contact trace when a positive case is identified through school-based testing in order to identify close contacts. Contact tracing will be conducted and communicated through the district nurse and school administration.

## **COVID-19 Positive Individuals**

When an individual tests positive for COVID-19, they are to remain at home and participate in distance learning for the CDC recommended period of isolation. We recommend that a student returning to in-person learning after a period of isolation chooses to wear a mask, as per CDC recommendations.

### **Close Contacts**

The district recommends that close contacts of a positive individual follow the guidelines from the CDC such as wearing a well-fitting mask for period of time, monitor for possible symptoms and test as appropriate.

## Parents and Visitors

Parents are welcome to enter the schools to drop-off and pick-up students at the beginning and end of the school day. At other times of the day parents may check-in at the school office, and when appropriate receive permission to visit a classroom.

## **Review Date**

The DBSD Smart Start Re-Opening Framework will be reviewed for possible revision by the School Board as needed for the remainder of the 2022-23 school and at least prior to end of January 2023.
